



## Promising Scholar Travel Scholarship for PWS Researchers

### **Amount:**

Two scholarships ranging from \$400-\$1000 each (subject to funding) one for an undergraduate/graduate student (master level) and another one for doctoral student or post-doctoral student

### **Established by:**

This scholarship was established by the PWCF Board of Directors to fund promising scientists doing research related to Prader-Willi Syndrome to attend a scientific meeting to present their research work.

### **Open to:**

This scholarship is open to current students pursuing undergraduate or graduate studies or post-doctoral studies at an educational institution or hospital in the state of CA.

### **Criteria:**

- ◆ Academic achievement
- ◆ Good academic standing
- ◆ Being a presenter in a scientific session on the topic of Prader-Willi Syndrome (abstract accepted or submitted for presentation)
- ◆ Potential for future work with people with PWS as clinician and/or researcher

### **Application Procedure:**

- 1) Complete the Scholarship application (answering all questions and signing the application);
- 2) Provide a resume or curriculum vitae documenting current and/or past involvement in scholarly activities;
- 3) Provide proof of submission of an abstract presentation to a scientific meeting or conference (provide copy of information and abstract submitted)

### **Application Deadline:**

- June 15<sup>th</sup> for Fall conferences
- December 15<sup>th</sup> for Spring conferences

- 5) Copy of your Resume or Curriculum Vitae (2 pages maximum)
