PERINATAL FACTORS TO CONSIDER FOR POTENTIAL PRADER-WILLI SYNDROME DIAGNOSIS

Prader-Willi syndrome (ICD-10-CM: Q87.11) should be considered a differential diagnosis if the fetus has the following perinatal factors:

- Polyhydramnios
- Decreased fetal movements
- Growth restriction
